# Job Shadow 2012: Growing the Partnership for Great Lakes IFT & MSU Food Science Students

2011 marked the beginning of a Job Shadow Program designed to enhance the Food Science education experience by taking a step beyond the books and into the real world of the food industry. Professional members of the Great Lakes IFT have formed a Job Shadow Committee to create and support this program. The job shadow program provides an opportunity for students to visit participating food companies for one or two days and connect with food business professional who work in the students' area of interest. Two Michigan food companies, Kalsec and Nestle participated in the pilot program the summer of 2011and five MSU students had job shadow visits. The program has been well received and plans are underway to expand with additional visits in the Spring/Summer of 2012. There are many students who are anxious to participate but limited "job shadow" visit opportunities. In order to add more job shadow opportunities for the students, we need to add more companies to the program. The time and resources required are minimal and the committee can walk you through the steps to get started.
